

Spudshed Hidden Tiger Hunt Competition

Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. The promoter is Vegie Bandits Pty Ltd (ACN 079 441 044) trading as Spudshed (ABN 31 079 441 044) (**Spudshed**).
2. Information on prizes and how to enter form part of these Terms and Conditions of Entry (**T&CE**).
3. By entering this competition entrants agree to be bound by these T&CE.
4. Entry is open to all West Australian residents aged up to 15 years old, excluding employees, suppliers and their immediate family members of Spudshed or any related entities (**Eligible Persons**).

How to enter

8. Entrants must:
 1. Collect a Hidden Tigers Hunt Sheet from the service desk
 2. Locate the 10 Hidden Tiger cards in-store
 3. Write down the correct locations of the 10 Hidden Tigers on the Hunt Sheet
 4. Complete their details on the Hunt Sheet
 5. Drop their completed Hunt Sheet into the corresponding entry box located at the front of the store.
9. Entrants who provide incorrect, misleading or fraudulent information are ineligible in the promotion and all entries of an entrant who is deemed by the Promoter to have provided incorrect or misleading information may, at the discretion of the Promoter be deemed invalid.
